Hong Kong Baptist University has five campuses. All MES18 activities are being held at the Shaw Campus in the Madam Kwok Chung Bo Fun Sports and Cultural Centre (Baptist University Road / Renfrew Road).

The venue is a 10-15 minute walk from Kowloon Tong MTR Station (exit E or A2) or a 5 minute minibus ride. Leave the station via exit B2 and locate the "Shaw Campus – Minibus No. 25M/25M(S).
